

***Eucharistic Precursors in the Old Testament***

Genesis 4:1-9- Offering first fruits to the Lord.

Genesis 14:17-24- Melchizedek- **priest** and Canaanite king, offers up bread and wine. He is the king of righteousness and the king of peace.

Ex 12:1-14- **Passover** origin.

**Covenant** theology-God makes a covenant with people and promises to be their God if they will obey his commands.

Genesis 15:7-18 God makes a covenant with Abraham and uses animal sacrifice to confirm. God promises land and descendants to Abraham and in return wants to be worshipped and obeyed.

Exodus 19:1-6- You will be my People and I will be your God.

Exodus 20: 1-17- Covenant of the 10 Commandments- What we need to follow.

Exodus 16:2-32- Manna in the desert, **bread** from heaven.

Exodus 24:3-8- Sprinkling of **blood** on the people to ratify the covenant.

2 Samuel 7:8-17- Covenant with David's line forever.

Jeremiah 31:31-34- A **new covenant** and new heart foretold.

Ezekiel 41:22-"Eating at the king's **table**," precursor to the table of the Eucharist.

Micah 5:2-4- **Bethlehem** will produce a shepherd to feed His people.

Malachi 1:10-14- purer **sacrifice** foretold everywhere!

1 Corinthians 10:1-4 recalls Old Testament references to the Sacrifice.
